

LIFE CHAIN CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Please arrive promptly, accounting for the time required for parking, sign pick-up, and positioning.
- 2. Stand along public sidewalks, spaced a couple of metres apart from fellow participants, facing traffic with your sign, ensuring you do not block pedestrians, driveways, or drivers' sightlines.
- 3. Commit to being peaceful and law-abiding. Do not physically interfere with passers-by and do not jostle for position if any counter-protesters block your Life Chain signs.
- 4. Avoid casual talk, frivolity, and arguments—even if initiated by passers-by. Life Chain is intended to be a somber and quiet prayer vigil. Be mindful of the message being presented to the public—through both signs and body language.
- 5. Refer police, media, local business owners, or other passers-by who want information to the organizer. Notify the organizer of any misconduct from passers-by or counterprotesters, so that he/she can respond.
- 6. Please do not display other signs, or distribute material, unless the organizer permits you to do so.
- 7. Please take care of your sign and return it to the organizer for use in future Life Chains.
- 8. Watch your small children at all times.
