**Part K, entitled "SOCIAL POLICY", article # 65 called "Abortion Legislation" which reads:** "A Conservative Government will not support any legislation to regulate abortion"

## STATE YOUR POLICY RESOLUTION.

Be it resolved that Article 65 of the 2016 National Policy Declaration be **deleted**.

## STATE YOUR RATIONALE.

Conflicts with Article 7 guaranteeing free votes to all members - including government ministers – on matters of conscience such as abortion.
Was undemocratically parachuted by the PMO into the plenary session at the 2005 Montreal Convention, without a prior vote by grassroots EDAs or party members.
Improperly purports to commit the "government" instead of the party.
Not reflective of the views of the majority of grassroots Conservative members, who have some distaste for Canada's abortion-on-demand, throughout all 40 weeks of pregnancy regime.
Its deletion will not commit the party to support the regulation of abortion.
